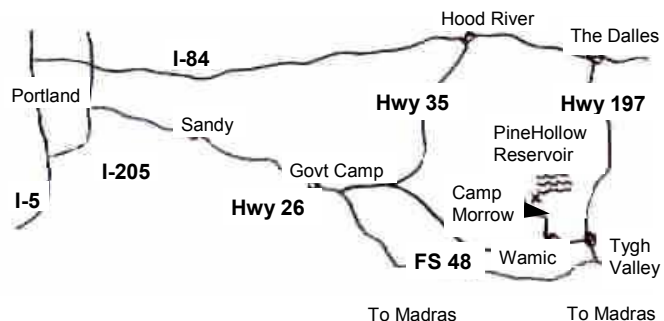
**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Options range from primitive cabins (bring your own bedding) to tent sites and primitive RV sites (no hook-ups).

**DIRECTIONS TO CAMP MORROW:**

Alternative Route from Portland: Take paved Forest Service Road #48 (also called "White River Road"), which begins in the Snow Park located where the White River crosses Highway 35, all the way to Wamic.

From Wamic, take Dotson Road past the log church, and follow for 3 miles until you arrive at Camp Morrow, on right hand side of the road.
