Check-out by 2:00 p.m. Saturday the 18th.

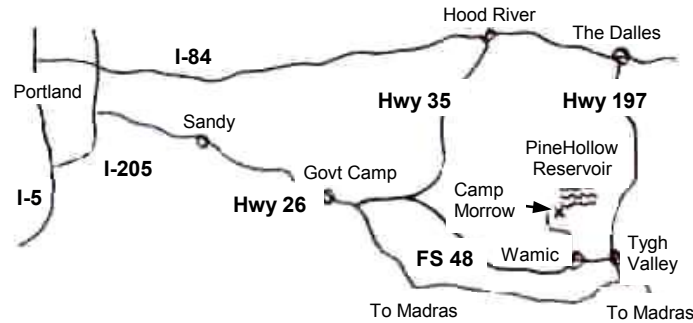

DIRECTIONS TO CAMP MORROW:
Take Highway 197 South from The Dalles for 28 miles and turn right at Tygh Valley and continue west 6 miles to Wamic.
Alternative Route from Portland: Take paved Forest Service Road #48 (also called "White River Road"), which begins in the Snow Park located where the White River crosses Highway 35, all the way to Wamic.
From Wamic, take Dotson Road past the log church, and follow for 3 miles until you arrive at Camp Morrow, on right hand side of the road.
